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#### 1. INTRODUCTION

ANDA would like to invite qualified and experienced service provider to provide electrical services at Emfundisweni Skills Development and Resource Centre

#### 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this solution is to provide installation, maintenance and linkage of our existing electrical metre boxes at Emfundisweni Skills Centre.

#### 3. BACKGROUND

Emfundisweni Skills Development and Resources Centre is one of the properties that were transferred to ANDA through the TFC process. Alfred Nzo Development Agency has a responsibility to maintain and manage all the properties that were transferred from the OR Tambo District Municipality to Alfred Nzo District Municipality after the new demarcation process. The Agency has been maintaining and supporting the center since the transfer of the property.

Alfred Nzo Development Agency as the managing Agent of Alfred Nzo District Municipality properties then converted most of the workers and established them as co-operatives. There are different business units in the centre formed as cooperatives to operate certain units of the Centre for business purposes, ANDA undertook the installation and separation of meter boxes at Emfundisweni Skills Development and Resource Centre to allow each business unit and tenants to be responsible for the overheads except for the 1x Main Admin Building which continues to be the responsibility of the center in terms of electricity costs.

Emfundisweni Skills Development Centre has signed an SLA document with Alfred Nzo Development Agency for Support, managing and maintenance of the Centre including payment of electricity costs from the Admin Building.

#### 4. SCOPE OF WORK

- Fixing and energising power on Damaged high mast.
- Re-dressing and labelling of Distribution boards.
- Disconnecting of live cables on door matrices
- Issuing of certificates of compliance
- Attend to fault findings.
